## IAS Line Count Filings Due June 30, 2009

All price-cap carriers and CETCs serving lines in the service area of a price-cap carrier, or their agent(s), are required to file line counts for Interstate Access Support (IAS) with the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) on a quarterly basis.

The next IAS line count filing is due by the last business day of the quarter, June 30, 2009, for the number of lines served as of March 31, 2009. Lines must be reported by UNE zone and customer class. (Residential and single line business lines are reported separately from multi-line business lines.)

If any of your filings are received after the filing dates, you will need to file a petition for waiver with the FCC. USAC is not authorized to waive the filing deadline, so only an FCC grant of a waiver will permit USAC to use your filings to calculate IAS.

CETCs must use Form 525, which is available at the USAC High Cost page, under [High Cost Tools: Required Forms, http://www.usac.org/hc/tools/required-forms.aspx](http://www.usac.org/hc/tools/required-forms.aspx). If an agent files on behalf of the company, the company must complete the top portion of the agent certification page and the agent is responsible for completing the bottom portion. Also, if the Form 525 is filed electronically (e.g., by fax, e-mail, or computer disk), the original, signed certifications of the authorized persons still must be received by USAC by the due date.
