

Local Switching Support (LSS) True-Up data are due by December 31, 2009

Incumbent Eligible Telecommunications Carriers (ETCs) who filed for LSS in 2008 must file actual data for calendar year 2008 no later than **December 31, 2009**. If your LSS data are not timely filed, your 2008 LSS will be recovered, absent a waiver from the FCC.

You must submit the necessary data on an OMB-approved LSS form, which can be found in the Forms Section of the USAC web site, [www.usac.org/hc/tools/required-forms.aspx](http://www.usac.org/hc/tools/required-forms.aspx). If you are an average schedule company, you should complete Form LSSa. If you are a cost company, you should complete Form LSSc. You must also submit the required certification form, attached to the instructions, for the above forms.

Whether you are an average schedule or a cost company, you may submit your Local Switching Form to USAC in one of three (3) ways:

If the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) files your LSS data on your behalf, NECA must submit the same data as required on the LSS forms. In addition, NECA must file your data with USAC no later than **December 31, 2009**.
