USAC's estimate of demand for Schools and Libraries Universal Service Support Mechanism discounts for Funding Year (FY) 2017 (July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018) is \$3.20 billion, of which \$2.296 billion is for Category 1 and \$904 million for Category 2. This estimate is based on total funds requested in FCC Form 471 applications received on or before May 11, 2017, the close of the FCC Form 471 filing window. A table showing estimated demand by service type and discount band is attached to this letter.
