NLAD Connectivity Issues - May 1 Consumer Fee Deadline Extended

April 29, 2022

USAC is actively working to resolve connectivity issues in the National Lifeline Accountability Database (NLAD). Users have been experiencing system errors and may be unable to complete system transactions. On April 21 and April 28, USAC released <u>bulletins</u> reminding providers of the May 1 deadline to backfill the consumer fee field for ACP subscribers. In light of the persisting NLAD connectivity issues, the May 1 deadline will be extended to ensure that providers have additional time to complete the field updates.

USAC will continue to update service providers on NLAD connectivity issues, and will provide additional information on the timeline to backfill the consumer fee field as soon as more information is available.

USAC will continue to distribute bulletins and conduct trainings to help service providers and other program participants understand the ACP Order and its effect on current and new program processes. USAC will also continue to update its <u>ACP service provider web content</u> to reflect updated ACP rules and processes.
