1. Do you anticipate the project filling the entire year term of the contract?

Though the contact is for one year, but it's anticipated the project will be completed faster.

2. This is a phase two. What percentage of the design pattern library would you say is already complete?

Indigo is roughly 60% completed at the moment, though it should be noted that pattern libraries continuously evolve to be congruent with technology and company developments. As a result, pattern libraries are never 100% completed, a little room for enhancements always exists. Also, note that Phase II has allotted for more tutorials and targeted developer trainings

3. Is there an incumbent bidding on the project?

There is no contractor currently providing these services to USAC.

III. Contract Term

4. Since this is an annual contract, is the expectation that the spend and invoicing be evenly distributed throughout the year? Or is it acceptable for the firm to spend and invoice as work demands (eg, months 1, 2, and 3 may be higher cost than months 4, 5, and 6).

Although the contract is for one year, it is anticipated the project will be completed faster. The terms and conditions require contractors to invoice once every 30 days or when the work is complete.

Only new components will be added to Figma. USAC's XD team has already transitioned the sticker sheets into Figma and vendor is welcome to use those.
