

# E-Rate Extends Customer Service Center Hours for Today's Tribal Library Application Deadline

May 26, 2022

Dear Tribal Partner,

The FY2022 application filing window for Tribal Libraries closes **today, May 26 at 11:59:59 p.m. ET**.

We continue to support applicants during the extended FY2022 E-Rate application filing window for new Tribal library applicants and for **applications that include at least one new Tribal library listed as a recipient of service.** 

The **Customer Service Center (CSC)** will be open additional hours today until the window closes at 11:59:59 ET. Please do not wait until the last minute to complete and certify your form, especially if you have questions or need additional assistance. You can reach the **CSC** at (888) 203-8100.

#### **Next Steps**

The required 28-day (minimum) competitive bidding process should have been initiated by filing the FCC Form 470 on or before April 28, in order for applicants to wait at least 28 days before submitting and certifying an FCC Form 471 before the window closes on May 26, 2022 at 11:59:59 p.m. ET. The FCC Form 470 is used by applicants to request bids for the eligible equipment and services that are needed and is posted on USAC's website for service providers to review and submit responsive bids to the applicants.

As a reminder, the FCC Form 471 is the funding application form that provides USAC with information about the services and/or equipment you are requesting and the entities that will receive the services and/or equipment during the upcoming funding year.

FCC Waiver Required for Out-of-Window Applications

FY2022 application cycle has two filing window deadlines set for two types of applications:

- The first filing window closed on March 22, 2022 for applications without at least one new Tribal library listed as a recipient of service.
- The FCC issued an order (<u>DA 22-231</u>) to waive the application filing deadline and extended the deadline to May 26, 2022 for new Tribal library applicants and applications with at least one new Tribal library listed as a recipient of service.

If an FCC Form 471 is filed after May 26, 2022, the applicant will need to file a waiver with the FCC regarding the application filing deadline. If granted by the FCC, then USAC will change the application status from out-of-window to in-window status, meaning that USAC can process the application as if it was submitted on time.

Please note: USAC cannot approve appeals or waiver requests that ask for a waiver of the E-Rate program rules—applicants must file a request for waiver with the FCC. View the <u>basic instructions</u> for filing the FCC Out-of-Window Waiver Requests.
