

# Lifeline's Q1 Tribal Webinar Next Month

# Dear Tribal Leader,

The Lifeline program, which is administered by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) under the policy guidance of the Federal Communications Commission, offers a monthly discount of up to \$9.25 toward phone or Internet services for eligible consumers and up to \$34.25 for those living on <a href="federally recognized Tribal lands">federally recognized Tribal lands</a>. Additionally, certain residents of Tribal lands can receive reimbursement for the full cost of starting service with certain phone or Internet companies at their primary residence, up to \$100, through Lifeline's Tribal Link Up benefit.

This year, USAC will host free quarterly Lifeline webinars for Tribal stakeholders (e.g., Tribal governments and government agencies and nonprofits serving Tribal communities) to enhance collaboration with Tribal communities.
