E-Rate

The <u>E-Rate program</u> provides funding to ensure that schools and libraries can obtain affordable, high-speed broadband services and internet equipment to connect today's students and library patrons with next-generation learning opportunities and services.

E-Rate Tribal Notice

On January 26, 2023, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) announced that it will consider a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking at the February 16 open meeting, seeking comment on ways to improve the E-Rate program rules and encourage greater Tribal participation in the E-Rate program. A copy of the proposed draft Notice of Proposed Rulemaking is available on the FCC's website. This document is released as part of a "permit-but-disclose" proceeding. Any presentations or views on the subject expressed to the FCC or its staff, including by email, must be filed in CC Docket No. 02-6, accessible at the FCC's Electronic Comment Filing System, and in accordance with the ex parte rules found at 47 CFR § 1.1200 et seq.

E-Rate Application Filing Window Now Open

The Funding Year (FY) 2023 FCC Form 471 (Apply for Discounts) application filing window opened on **Wednesday**, **January 18, 2023** and closes on Tuesday, March 28, 2023, at 11:59 p.m. ET.

Tuesday, February 28, 2023 is the last date to submit and certify your Competitive Bidding Form (FCC Form 470) to start the <u>competitive bidding process</u> and still wait the required minimum 28-day period before submitting and certifying your FCC Form 471 by the March 28, 2023 filing window deadline.

The E-Rate competitive bidding form and application must be filed in the <u>E-Rate Productivity Center</u> (EPC), the E-Rate account and management online system. The dates and times above apply to the time the form is certified in

EPC. If you complete all the required information on the form before the deadline but certify it after the deadline, the form will not be considered as timely filed.

Get Started - File Early

USAC recommends that you submit your program application (FCC Form 471) as early in the application filing window as possible so USAC can begin the processes necessary to review your applications and issue timely funding commitment decisions. To start the FY2023 <u>application filing process</u>, follow the steps below.

- Gain EPC Access EPC is the account and application management portal for the E-Rate program.
- First-time Filers If you are new to the E-Rate program, you will need a user account in EPC. For security purposes, you will also need credentials for One Portal, our multi-factor authentication system. Call the Customer Service Center (CSC) at (888) 203-8100 to set up your organization's EPC profile and your account administrator.
- Review the Eligible Services List The Eligible Services List (ESL) for each funding year provides guidance on the eligibility of products and services under the E-Rate program.

- Competitive Bidding (FCC Form 470)
 - Start the <u>Competitive Bidding Process</u> by filing your <u>FCC Form 470</u>, which is the first form in the application process.
 - Remember that **you must wait the required minimum 28-day period** after filing the FCC Form 470 before entering into an agreement with your selected service provider(s) and filing your FCC Form 471 application(s).

- Submit Your Application (FCC Form 471)
 - Apply for E-Rate funding by submitting and certifying your FY2023 FCC Form 471, **before the March 28, 2023**, filing window deadline.

E-Rate Tribal Libraries Pilot Program

In 2022, the FCC adopted a Report and Order (<u>Tribal Library Order</u>), updating the definition of a library and clarifying that Tribal libraries are eligible for support through the E-Rate program. To support newly eligible Tribal libraries, the FCC and USAC created the <u>E-Rate Tribal Library Pilot Program</u>, a hands-on approach to provide training, resources, and guidance to first-time E-Rate applicants. USAC is now working with several first time Tribal library E-Rate applicants, providing potential applicants with one-on-one assistance in all aspects of preparing, applying, and receiving E-Rate support during the FY2023 funding year. If you know of any Tribal libraries that might be interested in learning more about funding from the E-Rate program, but did not sign up for the pilot program, please contact <u>TribalTraining@usac.org</u> to get started.

Rural Health Care

The <u>Rural Health Care</u> (RHC) program provides funding to eligible health care providers to reduce the cost of eligible telehealth broadband and telecom services. RHC has two primary programs: the <u>Healthcare Connect Fund (HCF)</u> <u>Program</u> and the <u>Telecommunications (Telecom) Program</u>.

The FY2023 filing window opened December 1, 2022 and closes April 3, 2023. This means that you can submit your funding requests (FCC Forms 462 or 466) no later than 11:59 p.m. ET April 3, 2023. We highly encourage you to submit your funding requests as early as possible in the filing window. Learn more about <u>filing windows</u>.

Lifeline

The <u>Lifeline program</u> offers a monthly benefit of up to \$34.25 off phone, internet, or bundled services for eligible subscribers living on Tribal lands. Subscribers can receive this benefit after confirming their eligibility to participate in the program and receiving service from an eligible telecommunications carrier.

ACP

The <u>Affordable Connectivity Program</u> (ACP) provides eligible households with a discount on broadband service and connected devices.

Households who qualify for ACP and are located on qualifying Tribal lands can receive discounts of up to \$75 per month toward internet service and a one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet purchased from a participating provider. The program also provides discounts of up to \$30 per month toward internet service for eligible residents on non-Tribal lands. Tuesday, February 28, 2023 is the last date to submit and certify an FCC Form 470 and still wait the required minimum 28-day period before filing your FCC Form 471 funding application.

Tuesday, March 28, 2023, the FY2023 FCC Form 471 application filing window closes at 11:59 p.m. ET.

RHC

Wednesday, February 8, 2023, RHC will host their <u>Healthcare Connect Fund Program</u> office hours webinar at 2 p.m. ET – <u>Register</u>.

Wednesday, February 15, 2023, RHC will host their <u>Telecommunications Program</u> office hours webinar at 2 p.m. ET – <u>Register</u>.

Tuesday, February 28, 2023, Health care providers should submit their FCC Forms 461 and 465 to ensure that they can be posted with sufficient time for the minimum 28-day competitive bidding period.
