There is one week left to apply to participate in the Schools and Libraries Cybersecurity Pilot Program (Pilot Program). The application filing window for FCC Form 484 Part 1 will close at **11:59 p.m. E.T. on Friday, November 1**. Applicants who want to participate in the Pilot Program must submit and certify their FCC Forms 484 Part 1 by that date to be considered as a participant for the program.
