# The E-Rate Program: Tips for New Tribal Applicants



## **Eligibility Information for Tribal Libraries**

A Tribal library is eligible for E-Rate support if a Tribal government entity designates a library as a Tribal library through Tribal Resolution, charter or ordinance, a letter from the Tribal Council, or a similar document. A Tribal Library must demonstrate that it has characteristics of a library, including **regularly scheduled hours, staff, and materials for library users**.

Tribal college and university (TCU) libraries that serve as public libraries in their communities are also eligible for E-Rate support.

## Additional Support for Tribal and TCU Libraries

With the establishment of the Tribal Library E-Rate Advocacy Program (T-LEAP), Tribal and TCU libraries can receive direct support in navigating the E-Rate application process, including one-on-one assistance when preparing applications, applying to the program, and receiving E-Rate support.

- 1 Obtain an FCC Registration Number.
- 2 Obtain a <u>Billed Entity Number (BEN)</u> and create a user profile in the <u>E-Rate Productivity Center (EPC)</u>.
