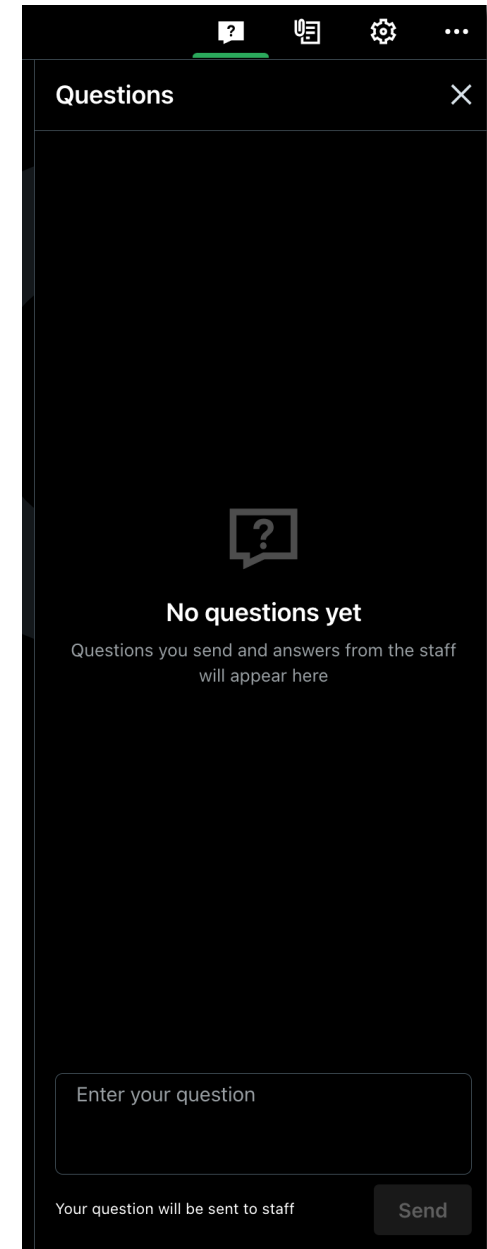

High Cost Program Overview

- High Cost ensures universal availability of essential telecommunications services in rural America.
- The program consists of more than 15 separate funds that distribute billions of dollars annually to carriers to provide voice and broadband service — both fixed and mobile — in rural areas that would otherwise be unserved or underserved.
- Legacy funds subsidize voice service to ensure universal access to basic telephone lines and calculate support based on carrier costs.
- Modernized funds, which make up the Connect America Fund, disburse set monthly payments to carriers to provide voice and broadband at required speeds in communities where the market alone cannot support the substantial cost of deploying network infrastructure and providing connectivity.
- Carriers that receive High Cost funding must offer service at rates reasonably comparable to those available in urban areas.

FCC Form 481: Overview

Form 481 Overview: Requirements

- All eligible telecommunications carriers (ETCs) participating in High Cost and/or Lifeline programs must file FCC Form 481 by Study Area Code (SAC) by July 1 annually.
- Form 481 collects financial and operational information used to validate carrier support.
- State utility commissions also rely on Form 481 data to perform the annual certification of ETCs under their jurisdiction to be able to receive High Cost support.
- This year's filing is for program year 2027 because the information collected will be used for disbursements for 2027.
- The data filed is from 2025, which is the most recent full calendar year for which data is available.
- Carriers that do not certify Form 481 by **July 1, 2026**, will see penalties in their disbursements the following month.

Disclaimer: ETCs that provide Lifeline service are subject to additional requirements not discussed in this webinar.

Form 481 Overview: Requirements

- Among other data, the Form 481 gathers information about:
 - Carrier ability to function in emergency situations.
 - Holding company, operating companies, affiliates and branding designations.
 - Tribal lands engagement.
 - Comparability of voice and broadband rates in rural and urban areas.
 - Terrestrial backhaul.
- Form 481 collects financial reports and full audited financial statements (including notes) from privately held ETCs. (FCC requires notes to financial statement submissions).
- Form 481 also includes three supply chain certifications:
 - Carriers must certify that no Universal Service support is being used to purchase, rent, lease, obtain or maintain any equipment or services designated by the FCC as posing a national security threat to the integrity of communications networks or the communications supply chain.

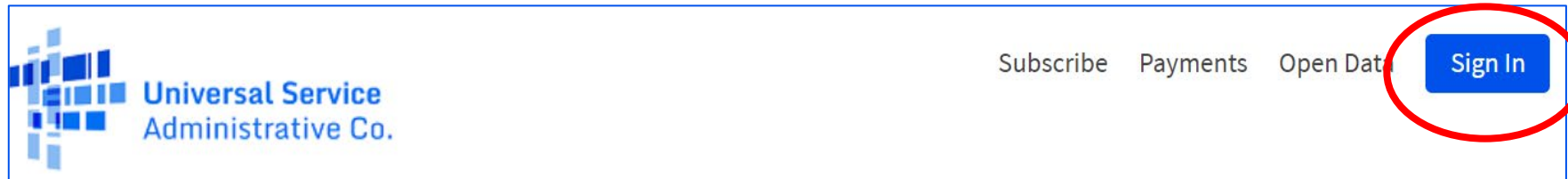
Form 481 Overview: System

- USAC has added several enhancements to the 481 system to improve the user experience.
 - Improved look and feel to the user interface
 - New tooltips to assist carriers in completing Section 800
 - Increased Confidentiality Request character limit to up to 4,000 characters
- Carriers are no longer required to submit separate copies of the FCC Form 481 filing to the FCC, state utility commissions or Tribal communities that they serve.

FCC Form 481: Accessing the System and Creating a Filing

Form 481: Accessing the System

- Users can access the Form 481 system through USAC's E-File system
 - E-File is available at <https://forms.universalservice.org/portal/login>.
 - Or click "Sign In" at the top of the USAC website (usac.org).



- Users must have a 481 entitlement. The carrier's 498 officer can assign the entitlement.
 - Form 481 SPO (Service Provider Officer): allows the user to enter and certify data.
 - Form 481 SPU (Service Provider User): allows the user to enter but not certify data (typically provided to users inside the carrier).
 - Form 481 SPA (Service Provider Agent): allows the user to enter but not certify data (typically provided to agents outside the carrier).

Form 481: Accessing the System

- If FCC Form 481 is not visible in the High Cost section of the E-File dashboard, the user may not have the necessary entitlement.
- User should request entitlement from the carrier's 498 Officer.
- Form 498 Officers and/or 498 General Contacts should reach out to USAC about missing entitlements or adjustments.

Form 481: Operating Companies

- Section 800 collects information about carrier operating companies and affiliates.
 - The Reporting Carrier should be the name associated with the Study Area Code (SAC) connected to the filing.
 - The holding company name will be pre-populated if USAC has one on file.
 - Operating Company (812) is the name of the corporate operating company.
 - Changing the holding company name for one SAC will change the holding company name for all other SACs associated with that holding company in the Form 481.
 - A carrier may attach a file listing any affiliates associated with the SAC completing this form. This should include affiliates that are designated as ETCs and their SACs, or that provide retail broadband internet access.

Form 481: Voice and Broadband Service Rate Comparability

- Section 1000 collects certifications that the carrier offers voice and broadband service at rates that are reasonably comparable to average urban rates.
 - Lines 1000 and 1010 collect information about voice rates.
 - Lines 1020 and 1030 collect information about broadband rates.
 - For lines 1010 and 1030, a carrier must attach a description detailing either compliance or non-compliance.
 - If the response to lines 1000 or 1020 is Not Applicable, lines 1010 or 1030 will not appear.
 - Line 1020: A carrier can only answer “Not Applicable” if it provides mobile broadband services not subject to this condition.



Form 481: Certify Filing

- Users can certify by individual SAC or bulk certify multiple SACs.
- Carriers must complete three supply chain certifications. (More in next section of presentation.)
 - Officers indicate yes or no to certify compliance with these rules.
 - If a carrier indicates that it is not in compliance, an additional line will appear for the carrier to attach a copy of an FCC waiver or pending waiver request. Carriers that answer “No” to 54.11 may be audited.

Form 481: Requesting Confidentiality

- USAC provides public access to most FCC Form 481 data submitted by carriers, excluding trade secrets and certain proprietary or sensitive commercial and financial information covered by FCC rules or protective orders.
- Carriers can request nondisclosure of additional information not already considered confidential by the FCC through the Form 481 filing system.
- Carriers have until **July 20, 2026**, to request confidential treatment of data submitted with the current Form 481 filing due by July 1, 2026.
- USAC will share confidentiality requests with the FCC for review and will not publish data under review until the FCC makes a determination on the request.
- USAC will make all other information public.

FCC Form 481: Supply Chain Certifications

Supply Chain Report and Order Overview

Carriers must submit annual supply chain certifications through Form 481 for each USF program in which they participate.

- The FCC issued the *Protecting the Communications Supply Chain Order* ([FCC 19-121](#)) in November of 2019. This order adopted 47 CFR **Section 54.9**, which:
 - States: “No Universal Service support may be used to purchase, obtain, maintain, improve, modify, or otherwise support any equipment or services produced or provided by any company posing a national security threat to the integrity of communications networks or the communications supply chain.”
 - Creates a process for the FCC’s Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (PSHSB) to designate companies subject to this prohibition.
- Section 54.9 went into effect on Jan. 3, 2020, and applies to all USF programs.
- In June of 2020, the PSHSB designated equipment and services produced or provided by Huawei and ZTE as subject to the prohibition in Section 54.9.
- Carriers began certifying compliance with Section 54.9 on Form 481 on April 1, 2021.

Supply Chain Report and Order Overview

- The FCC issued the *Supply Chain Second Report and Order* ([FCC 20-176](#)) in December of 2020. This order adopted 47 CFR **Section 54.10**, which:
 - Prohibits the use of any “federal subsidy made available through a program administered by the Commission that provides funds to be used for the capital expenditures necessary for the provision of advanced communications service” to purchase, rent, lease, obtain or maintain any “covered communications equipment or services” that pose an “unacceptable risk to the national security of the United States or the security and safety of United States persons.”
 - All USF programs are subject to this prohibition.
- While Section 54.9 applies only to communications equipment and services produced or provided by Huawei or ZTE (as designated by the PSHSB), Section 54.10 applies to all “covered communications equipment and services.”
 - The FCC released the initial Covered List ([DA 21-309](#)) in March of 2021.
 - The list included telecommunications equipment produced by Huawei, ZTE, Hytera, Hangzhou Hikvision and Dahua.
- Carriers began certifying compliance with Section 54.10 on Form 481 on April 1, 2022.

Supply Chain Report and Order Overview

- Based on national security determinations made by Congress and agencies and bodies with appropriate national security expertise, the FCC has updated the Covered List several times.
 - The most recent addition to the Covered List was foreign-produced consumer-grade routers ([DA 26-278](#)).
- The most recent addition also established conditional approval process.
 - An executive interagency body with appropriate national security expertise can grant exemption to specific devices if the Department of War and/or Department of Homeland Security determines that such devices do not pose unacceptable risks to national security.

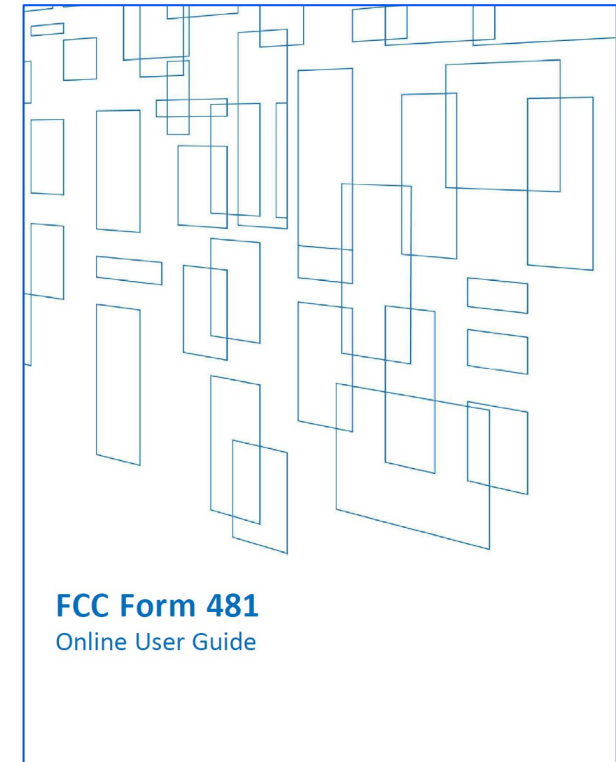
