NV APIs v1.1.0

UI Enhancements

- The eligibility resolution page, specifically for program eligibility, has been enhanced to include a new tool tip offering consumers additional information on the SNAP program.



Availability of API Specifications

- The NV API Specifications are now available under the Reports and tools section of the left-hand navigation panel in NLAD.

Revisions to Look Up Subscriber API Request

- Two new fields related to RAD were added to the lookupSubscriber request. repId and repNotAssisted are not available for optional use in the production environment.

Ignore Empty Rows in Batch File Upload

- The system will ignore empty rows rather than return an error when users upload a batch file for subscriber transactions on the Upload Subscriber File page.

Fix for Issues with IE 11

- Various issues related to Internet Explorer 11 have been resolved, including drop down menus that did not function as expected in this browser.

RAD 1.7.0

Prevent NLAD Access during Lock Out

- Representatives will no longer be able to log in to NLAD if their Representative ID is locked. They will receive the following error:
