

# **FY2020 Funding Requests**

- Last month RHC started issuing decisions on FY2020 funding requests (FCC Forms 462 & 466), and will continue to do so on a rolling basis.
- All qualifying FY2020 funding requests will be fully funded.
  - On October 19, the FCC released Order DA 20-1233, waiving the upfront payment and multi-year commitment sub-cap of \$152.7M.
- There will not be a second filing window for FY2020.
- The deadline for Information Requests has been extended by <u>DA 20-1021</u>.
  - The FCC has extended the gift rule waiver and information request deadline to December 31, 2020. These waivers were originally set to expire on September 30, 2020.

# **FY2020 Funding Demand**

- The total demand for FY2020 is \$670.14 million, which includes \$648.24 million in gross demand for all program funding requests during the funding year's single application filing window.
  - FY2020 had \$804.74M in available funding.
  - Of the requested support, \$195.46 million represents applications seeking support for upfront payments and multi-year commitments in the HCF Program.

# **Next Steps for FY2020 Applicants**

- When you receive a funding commitment letter (FCL):
  - Review details carefully.
  - Prepare to invoice: The invoicing deadline for both Telecom and single-year HCF FY2020 requests is October 28, 2021.
- If you are awaiting a decision:
  - Be on the lookout for any information requests
  - Ensure account holders are up-to-date

# **New for FY2020 & Forward: Funding Prioritization**

- In the event eligible funding requests exceed available funding amount, the FCC's rules provide for the prioritization of support based on the rurality tier of the HCP site and whether the site is located in a Medically Underserved Area/Population (MUA/P).
- HCPs located in more rural areas that are designated MUA/P are given a higher priority than sites in less rural and non-MUA/P areas.

This funding request was submitted during the FY2020 Filing Window Period 1, and the HCP is assigned funding priority category *Priority 3*. For each filing window, if the total demand for RHC Program funding exceeds the total remaining funding available for the funding year, USAC

will fully fund all eligible requests falling in the first prioritization category before funding requests in the next lower prioritization category. If there is insufficient funding to fully fund all requests in a particular prioritization category, USAC will prorate the funding available among all eligible requests received in that prioritization category. The total cap pro-rata factor for this funding request is 92.52804%. Therefore, the funding commitment is: 92.52804% \* \$7,800.00 = \$7,217.19




# **Priority Category Display**

- For FY2020 and forward, every site is assigned a rurality tier that determines the HCP priority category.
  - A site's rurality tier is a factor in the prioritization of funding in the event eligible funding requests exceed the amount of available funding for a particular funding year.
  - It is also used to calculate the "rural rate" for determining the amount of support for eligible telecommunications services to the site location for the RHC Telecom Program
- My Portal now displays an HCP's priority category.




# **Rurality Tier Search Tool: Additional Guidance**


- If your address does not show results when using the <u>Rurality Tier Search Tool</u>, you can enter your site's geolocation (the latitude and longitude.
- To find your site's coordinates:
  - 1. Go to Google Maps
  - 2. Type in your site's address
  - 3. Right click on the marker pin pointing your site on the map and select "What's Here?"
  - 4. The coordinates (a pair of numbers, each with a decimal point) will appear on the screen
- Use these coordinates to "Search with geographic coordinates" in the Rurality Tier Search Tool. Be sure to include the negative sign when entering the negative longitude coordinate.

# **Invoicing Updates**


- For FY2020 and forward, invoicing is now based on the **service delivery deadline.** 
  - The "service delivery deadline" is replacing the term "funding end date."
  - The service delivery deadline for all services is June 30 of the funding year for which support was sought. Extensions of the service delivery deadline are available for non-recurring services in limited circumstances.
  - The FY2020 invoice deadline for single year HCF and Telecom Programs is October 28, 2021.
- Telecom invoice deadline implemented to mirror HCF Program.
- Deadlines displayed in My Portal and included on FCL and HSS.

# **Telecom Changes – Service Provider View**







# **Telecom Changes – HCP View**

# **Awaiting Decision on FY2020**

- If you are waiting on an FY2020 decision or multi-year commitment/evergreen determination, we recommend filing an FCC Form 461 or 465 to competitively bid for FY2021.
  - Information for FY2020 and FY2021 Applicants Tip Sheet
- Applicants interested in applying for FY2021 funding should submit their forms prior to window close, regardless of their FY2020 pending form status.
  - FY2021 Filing Window: 01/04/2021 04/01/2021 at 11:59 EST.
- Please be sure to include a cover letter when you submit your FY2021 request explaining your competitive bidding process and include the associate FY2020 FRN for reference.
  - Without an explanation, your FY2021 funding request could be perceived as a duplicate request and denied as such. RHC reviewers will work directly with applicants on specific applications.

### **Reminder: FCC Form 467 Revisions**

- Please remember to carefully review your Funding Commitment Letter (FCL) and Healthcare Support Schedule (HSS) prior to beginning the invoicing process.
- If there is an error or you have any questions about the information on the FCL or HSS, email <a href="mailto:RHC-Assist@usac.org">RHC-Assist@usac.org</a> with the FRN in the subject line.
- As a reminder, if services were delayed or not turned on, it is the responsibility of the HCP to submit a request for an FCC Form 467 revision.

### **Reminder: Account Holders**

- Please ensure all account holders are up to date for all HCPs.
- We recommend having at least one secondary account holder per HCP.

# **Connected Care Pilot Program**

- Will provide up to \$100 million over a three-year period to support the provision of connected care services, with an emphasis on supporting these services for low income Americans and veterans.
- Will provide funding to cover 85% of the eligible costs of broadband connectivity, network equipment, and information services necessary to provide connected care services to the intended patient population.
- USAC will determine eligibility for the program using the existing FCC Form 460.


