





August 499-Q Notes

- 1. The August FCC Form 499-Q must be filed by Monday, August 3, 2020
 - Revisions must be completed by Thursday, September 17, 2020.
- 2. This 499-Q is completed by the filer to project or estimate their revenues for October, November and December 2020. (reported on Lines 119 & 120 of the 499-Q form). This is your last projection for calendar year 2020.
- 3. For calendar year 2020, filers that expect to bill less than **\$47,169.81** of combined interstate and international revenues will be considered *de minimis* for 2020. This is an estimate only, because not all of the quarterly contribution factors have been finalized for calendar year 2020.
- 4. REMINDER! Filers are no longer required to email USAC their quarterly traffic studies......

 however you need to save them and submit as documentation to support your jurisdictional breakout on the 2021 FCC Form 499-A (next year's form).



Types of FCC Form 499

FCC Form 499-A

- 1. Required for all filers
- 2. The FCC Form 499-A is the annual form used to report the company's actual revenue billed during the prior calendar year.
- 3. The FCC Form 499-A is due annually on April 1.

FCC Form 499-Q

- 1. Required for all non-de minimis filers
- 2. The <u>FCC Form 499-Q</u> is used to *project* or *forecast* the company's revenue for the <u>next</u> calendar quarter.
- 3. The FCC Form 499-Q due dates:
 - February 1
 - May 1
 - August 1
 - November 1

ALL FCC Forms must be submitted online through E-File. Paper copies are not accepted.



Who Must File

- 1. Every <u>non</u> de minimis telecommunications company <u>must</u> file the FCC Form 499-Q.
- 2. De minimis filers are not required to file the FCC Form 499-Q, but they are requested to email USAC each quarter to notify of their continued de minimis status for the upcoming quarter.
 - Send the email to 'Form499@usac.org'
 - ♦ Include your Filer ID, Company name and the reporting period (i.e February 499-Q) for which you expect to be de minimis.

So the key question is - what exactly is a de minimis company??



Define "de minimis"

Definition of *de minimis*

A filer qualifies for *de minimis* status for a given calendar year when the revenue reported on its corresponding FCC Form 499-A is such that the calculated annual contribution to the federal Universal Service Fund is less than \$10,000.

Which leads to the question, "How do I know what my annual contribution will be for a quarter?"

Looking at it from a REVENUE standpoint, USAC can "guestimate" (based on the FCC estimation factor)what the *de minimis* revenue threshold will be for calendar year 2020, as we don't know the 3rd and 4th quarter contribution rates yet.

For calendar year 2020, filers that bill less than **\$47,169.81** of combined interstate and international telecommunication revenues will be considered *de minimis* for 2020.

◆ This amount is an estimate only, based on the FCC Estimation Factor, as the actual quarterly contribution factors for CY 2020 are determined each quarter throughout the year .

The FCC Form 499-Q includes a table to help you determine your status each quarter.



Help determining "de minimis" status

Included in the instructions for every FCC Form 499-Q is a table (Figure 1) designed to help the filer determine if they are *de minimis* or not.

Prior to completing the table, you must 'manually' fill out a 499-Q, because the revenue numbers reported on your draft copy will be used to complete the table.

Complete the table in Figure 1 of the 2020 FCC Form 499-Q instructions to determine if your projections qualify you as a *de minimis* filer for the upcoming quarter.

Note: Actual contribution factors for future quarters may increase or decrease depending on quarterly changes in program costs and the contribution base.

IMPORTANT: *IF* the actual Contribution Factor exceeds the *Estimation* factor (.212) for a quarter you may receive an invoice from USAC, unless you have sent an email during the 499-Q open period notifying use that the company expects to be *de minimis*.

Filers whose actual contribution requirements total \$10,000 or more are required to contribute to the universal service support mechanisms and must file this Worksheet.

Lines 3 & 4 report revenue for affiliates

Lines 5 & 6 report consolidated revenue

Lines 8 & 10 are used to determine if a carrier is LIRE (mainly international usage)

Line 12 is used to back out any federal USF you invoice your customers (this would be included in lines 1 & 2, but not included in base)

If Line 17 results in \$10,000 or less, then you are de minimis.


Online Filing – Before You Start

- Make sure your internet browser's 'pop up blocker' is OFF.
 - The system opens a new window to display the data entry screen for the FCC Form 499-Q.
 - If you have clicked 'Create New Form' and you don't see a new, smaller window you most likely have the pop-ups blocked.
- Ensure sure these email addresses from USAC don't go to your SPAM folder!
 - Important USAC communication comes from the following emails
 - √ 'form499@usac.org'
 - √ 'CustomerSupport@usac.org'
 - √ 'form499@universalservice.org'
- Not sure if you are de minimis or not? FILE the form anyway!
 - We would rather have you report your revenues than us having to estimate on your behalf.


Once logged in to E-File, the new service provider portal will appear. Only systems in which you have authorization to access will appear. In this example, the user can only access the 498 ID and the 499 Filer ID. Select 'Manage FCC Forms 499'.



To start a 499-Q, select 'Create New Form' from the Information Center on the left hand side. Once in the 'Create New Form' section, you'll have the option to select the filing you are working on. Be sure to enter the Filer ID and then click on the 'Create New Filing' button to get started.



Block 1: Contributor Identification Information will be prepopulated. If the data does not have a field box, you cannot change it.



Block 2: Contact Information will also be prepopulated.

- This section contains the name, phone number and email of the person preparing the form.
- It also contains the billing contact name and the billing address. USAC sends out paper copies of their invoice. If this address needs to be updated, you can do that here.







Revise the FCC Form 499-Q

The Form 499-Q has a very short revision window of 45 days!

This is because the data collected on the form is time sensitive.

USAC uses the data for invoicing as well as determining the USF contribution factor.

DETAILED SUMMARY OF CHARGES AND CREDITS

SUPPORT MECHANISM CHARGES

Your monthly support mechanism charges were calculated according to the following formulas:

Quarterly Contribution Base

The quarterly contribution base is a portion of your quarterly revenue that USAC considers when determining your quarterly Universal Service Fund contribution. The quarterly contribution base equals your interstate plus international revenue. Your current quarterly contribution base equals:

Adjusted Quarterly Contribution

USAC adjusts carriers' quarterly contribution bases by the amount that they are expected to contribute in that quarter. The calculation for an adjusted contribution amount is as follows, and takes into account the circularity deduction:

De Minimis Eligibility

Carriers whose expected annual contribution is less than \$10,000 are considered de minimis and are exempted from paying into the Universal Service Fund. To be exempt, a carrier must meet the de minimis criteria on both the current 499A and 499Q forms.




