498 ID & 499 ID

What are these IDs?

What The IDs Are

<u>498 ID</u>

Takes it's name from the registration form - FCC Form 498

Identification used to *receive* Universal Service funding

<u>499 ID</u>

Takes it's name from it's registration form – FCC Form 499-A

Identification used to *contribute* to the Universal Service Fund



ID Difference

498 Identification Number

aka SPIN (Service Provider Identification Number), 498 ID Nine digit number beginning with "143" (i.e. 143999999)

Who - Telecommunications Providers, Service Providers, Schools, Libraries

Why - to participate in any of the 4 programs USAC administers: *Rural Health Care*, *High Cost*, *Lifeline*, *E-Rate*

How - Complete Form 498

499 Filer ID

aka Filer ID, 499 ID, 6 digit number Six digit number beginning with an "8" (i.e. "889993")

Who - Telecommunications Providers, including VoIP service providers

Why - to contribute to the Universal Service Fund

How - Complete Form 499-A

Companies that have a 498 ID don't necessarily have to have a 499 ID, and vice versa!

2021 Filing Calendar

When to File the FCC Forms 499

Types of FCC Form 499

FCC Form 499-A

- 1. Required for all filers
- 2. The <u>FCC Form 499-A</u> is the annual form used to report the company's *actual* revenue billed during the <u>prior</u> calendar year.
- **3.** The FCC Form 499-A is due annually on April 1.

FCC Form 499-Q

- 1. Required for all non-*de minimis* filers
- 2. The <u>FCC Form 499-Q</u> is used to *project* or *forecast* the company's revenue for the <u>next</u> calendar quarter.
- **3.** The FCC Form 499-Q due dates:
 - February 1
 - May 1
 - August 1
 - November 1

ALL FCC Forms must be submitted online through E-File. Paper copies are not accepted.

Who is Required to File the 499-Q

Who Must File

- 1. Every <u>non</u> *de minimis* telecommunications company <u>must</u> file the FCC Form 499-Q.
- 2. *De minimis* filers are not required to file the FCC Form 499-Q, but they are requested to email USAC each quarter to notify of their continued *de minimis* status for the upcoming quarter.
 - Send the email to 'Form499@usac.org'
 - Include your Filer ID, Company name and the reporting period (i.e February 499-Q) for which you
 expect to be *de minimis*.

So the key question is - what exactly is a *de minimis* company??

Definition of *de minimis*

A filer qualifies for *de minimis* status for a given calendar year when the revenue reported on its corresponding FCC Form 499-A is such that the calculated annual contribution to the federal Universal Service Fund is less than \$10,000.

Which leads to the question, "How do I know what my annual contribution will be for a quarter?"

Looking at it from a BILLED REVENUE standpoint, USAC can only "guestimate" (based on the FCC estimation factor)what the *de minimis* revenue threshold will be for calendar year 2021, as we don't know the contribution rates in 2021 will be yet.

For calendar year 2020, filers that billed less than **\$52,318.66** of combined **end user** interstate and international telecommunication revenues will be considered *de minimis* for 2020.

> This is not an estimate, as the contribution factors for calendar year 2020 are all final.

Help determining "de minimis" status

Included in the instructions for every FCC Form 499-Q is a table (Figure 1) designed to help the filer determine if they are *de minimis* or not.

Please watch the recorded webinar for FCC Form 499-Q Basics for a detailed description of this Figure 1.

While filling out Figure 1 is a more 'precise' method for determining *de minimis* status, keep in mind we don't know actual contribution factors, so this method is NOT foolproof!

A quick guesstimate would be to take the stated revenue *de minimis* level for 2020 - \$52,318.66.

Divide that number by 4 = \$13,079. That's how much revenue you'd be reporting on Line 120 of your FCC Form 499-Q in order to be on or near the *de minimis* threshold.

Again, you may need to adjust for the contribution factor. The higher the factor, the lower this number will be. And if you are within \$1,000 of this, just file the form to be safe.

Adjusted Quarterly Contribution

USAC adjusts carriers' quarterly contribution bases by the amount that they are expected to contribute in that quarter. The calculation for an adjusted contribution amount is as follows, and takes into account the circularity deduction:





De Minimis Eligibility

Carriers whose expected annual contribution is less than \$10,000 are considered de minimis and are exempted from paying into the Universal Service Fund. To be exempt, a carrier must meet the de minimis criteria on both the current 499A and 499Q forms.

You meet the de minimis criteria on neither the 499A or the current 499Q. Therefore, you are not eligible for the de minimis exemption during the current quarter.

Your eligibility was calculated using the contribution factors established by the FCC for determining de minimis status on each form:

Support Mechanism Charges

Purpose of the FCC Form 499-A Required Annual Filing

What is it?

A company reports their actual historical revenues on the FCC Form 499-A.

The 2021 FCC Form 499-A reports actual revenues from calendar year 2020.

USAC takes the numbers on the 2021 FCC Form 499-A and compares them to the projected revenue from the quarterly FCC Forms 499-Q.

- November 2019 Filing
- February 2020 Filing
- May 2020 Filing
- August 2020 Filing

Compare 499-Q revenue to the 499-A revenue

If the company's projected revenues for calendar year 2019, reported on the FCC Form 499-Q, are **too high**, USAC will calculate your credit.

The company 'contributed' too much over the year.

If the company's projected revenues are **too low**, USAC will calculate a "trueup charge" to make up for the contribution deficit.

The company didn't contribute enough over the year.

These charges/credits will appear on the company's July invoice from USAC.
How to Create a New Form

Start a New Form Online

Remember! All FCC Forms 499-A and 499-Q must be submitted online.

• Paper copies are NOT accepted.

Currently, the 2021 FCC Form 499-A has not been finalized and NOT online. Check back near the end of February 2021 for an announcement.

• Filers will also be notified via email that the form is ready.

USAC's online system, E-File, will display a data entry screen, guiding the user through reporting the revenue on the form.

• These screens do NOT look like the paper copy of the form.

Online Filing the FCC Form 499

Once logged in to E-File, the new service provider portal will appear. Only systems in which you have authorization to access will appear. In this example, the user can only access the 498 ID and the 499 Filer ID.



Online Filing the FCC Form 499

The FCC reviews and updates the FCC Form 499-A prior to releasing it for the year. Until the new form has been released, you will not see the form listed. Typically, the FCC releases the updated FCC Form 499-A in late February.

To start the FCC Form 499-A, select 'Start Form' from the row containing the FCC Form 499-A.
