USF Contribution Factors

USF Contribution Factor

- Published by the FCC
- Changes quarterly usually published 2 weeks before the quarter begins.
- <u>1Q 2023 Public Notice</u> 32.6%
- List of past contribution factors found on both <u>USAC</u> and <u>FCC</u> Websites
- Used to determine a service providers monthly contribution to the Federal Universal Service Fund

Circularity Factor

 USAC will reduce each provider's contribution obligation by a circularity discount or factor, approximating the provider's contributions in the upcoming quarter.

The circularity factor also changes quarterly


It is published along with the quarterly contribution factor.

1Q 2023 Circularity factor is 0.245701.

Service Provider Contribution Base

- The Federal Universal Service contribution is based on a service provider's contribution base.
- Contribution Base = End-user telecommunications revenue, interstate and international
- For each quarter, USAC uses the revenues reported on the FCC Form 499-Q to determine the contribution amount

Contribution Calculation

Found on page 2 of your monthly printed invoice

Calculation of a quarterly contribution base:

Quarterly Contribution Base


The quarterly contribution base is a portion of your quarterly wenue that USAC considers when determining your quarterly Universal Service Fund contribution. The quarterly contribution base equals your intente plus international revenue. Your current quarterly contribution base equals:

\$ 76,921.25	+	\$ 0.00	1922	\$ 76,921.25
Interstate Revenue (Line 1208)		International Revenue (Line 120C)	=	Quarterly Contribution Base

Calculation of a contribution obligation for the quarter:

Adjusted Quarterly Contribution

USAC adjusts carriers' quarterly contribution bases by the amount that they are expected to contribute in that quarter. The dation for an adjusted contribution amount is as follows, and takes into account the circularity deduction:
