FCC Form 499-Q February 1, 2022	2Q projected 2022 4Q revenue 2021	March 18, 2022	April – June 2022
FCC Form 499-A April 1, 2022	Prior year: 2021 January – December	March 31, 2023	July 2022
FCC Form 499-Q May 2, 2022*	3Q projected 2022 1Q revenue 2022	June 16, 2022	July – September 2022
FCC Form 499-Q August 1, 2022	4Q projected 2022 2Q revenue 2022	September 15, 2022	October – December 2022
FCC Form 499-Q November 1, 2022	1Q projected 2023 3Q revenue 2022	December 16, 2022	January – March 2023

Revising an FCC 499-Q After The Deadline

- The revenue submitted on a revision after the deadline will not be used for invoicing purposes.
- Revisions may be submitted after the deadline to stop the monthly late filing fees that occur for not filling out a required FCC Form 499-Q.
- If a filer requests USAC to accept a revision after the revision deadline, know that USAC does not have the authority to do so. The filer must request a waiver of the filing deadline directly with the FCC. Please contact 'Form499@usac.com' for further instructions.


Revising an FCC 499-A After The Deadline

- IF a revision to the annual form is submitted that results in the USF contribution base decreasing, the revision will not be accepted.
- If a revision to the annual form is submitted and the contribution base increases, USAC analysts will review the form and ask further questions if required.
- USAC analysts may require a filer to submit out of period revisions to correct revenue that we have determined has been incorrectly reported.
- Revisions may be submitted after the deadline to stop the monthly late filing fees that occur for not filling out a required FCC Form 499-A.
