# Manage Your 499 Filer ID

## **Registration Information**

#### **Ensure Company Information is Accurate**

At least once a year, review the registration information contained in Block 1 and Block 2 of the FCC Form 499-A to ensure the information is current.

Typically, this review can be done while completing the annual form, the FCC Form 499-A due April 1 of every year.

During the year, if any name, address or registration information changes, please update within 30 days of the change.

### **Registration Information**

#### **Changes to be Completed by USAC**

- Company name change
- EIN change
- DBA

You must send in a copy of the W-9 showing the correct information to 'Form499@usac.org' and request USAC update the information.

## **Billing Address Information**

#### **Billing Address Should be Verified**

The detailed monthly paper invoice explaining how the contribution amount is calculated is mailed to the designated address. It is the service provider's responsibility to ensure that the address is current.

Can be updated on the current FCC Form 499-Q (quarterly form).

#### **Deactivate the 499 Filer ID**

Select the form that matches the company's situation from the "Manage Your 499 ID" webpage.




It is important to notify USAC and deactivate the 499 Filer ID in E-File if the company is no longer in business or selling telecommunications. USAC treats all active 499 Filer IDs as active companies, and will continue to invoice contributions, late filing fees and requiring annual forms to be submitted.

#### **Maintain Authorized Users**

#### Company Officers should periodically review authorized users.

From upper righthand corner, click on down arrow next to username, then select 'Add/Remove 499 Users' option.

## New Planned E-File Feature – 499-Q DM Notification

- A new feature is planned for E-File in October 2023: FCC Form 499-Q De Minimis Notification Enhancement
- This new feature will provide:
  - Service Provider users a one-button tool to communicate de minimis status to USAC.
  - In so doing, communication that previously occurred using e-mail will be performed directly in E-File.
